#### **Behaviour at Heronsgate**

In order to ensure there are clear expectations of behaviour at Heronsgate we have reviewed the behaviour policy and have reintroduced the expectations of behaviour we wish to see, under three key headings, Respectful, Responsible and Safe. These are all closely linked to our school values and the links are discussed with the children in assemblies and in class. Reminders are given when required and we continue to use our rewards to praise children when they are following our expectations and demonstrating our values. Posters which clearly list our expectations are visible in classes and all areas of the school. These act as reminders for the children and adults and are referred to when needed. Our expectations are as follows:

#### Respectful

#### Remain seated where you are expected to sit

Sit still and only leave when you have permission

#### Listen to the person who is talking

Show good body language and wait for your turn to speak

#### Have a positive attitude

Don't give up. Look for ways to help yourself

#### Wearing the correct school uniform

Following the school expectations

#### Responsible

#### Be Honest

You are responsible for your actions so always tell the truth

#### Be Resilient

You are responsible for your learning so have a go yourself and always try your hardest

#### Look after the school environment

You are responsible for your learning environment, keep it clean and tidy

#### **Use good manners**

You are responsible for how you speak and act towards others, think before you speak and act with kindness

#### <u>Safe</u>

#### Show Heronsgate way of walking

Walk silently in single file when moving around the school passing the door carefully to the next person

#### Make sure an adult always knows where you are

Ask permission before leaving the classroom

#### **Follow adults instructions**

Respond straight away

#### Keep yourselves and others safe

Behave in a responsible, respectful way
